Are You Pregnant or Parenting?

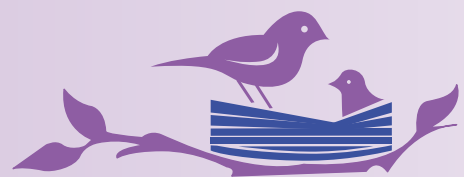

Basic Admission Requirements:

- 20 years of age and under.
- Currently expecting, and/or parenting a child under the age of 5
- Willing to continue your education, attend a local church and volunteer in the community
- Be willing to live in a group setting with your own room, completing assigned chores and following rules that have the benefit of all those living in the house

The Branch Resource Center helps any parent in need. You may fill 2 reusable bags 1 time per month for a total of three months. After that time you may choose to attend counseling sessions with our licensed counselor (some may qualify for a sliding scale fee), attend parenting support classes, volunteer at our administrative offices, or attend our Single Mom's Support Group, and receive additional supplies if needed. We offer:

- Essential baby supplies and other baby items (diapers, wipes, lotion, ointment, clothing, etc.)
- Personal care items and referrals for additional resources if needed
- Counseling (if you are interested in counseling contact our office for a referral to Christian Family Services, Lisa Randolph)
- Parenting support classes (call 636.336.2534 for availability)
